## 2 GO

### WASH CLOTH SLIPPERS



#### MATERIALS NEEDED:

Two washcloths  
Matching thread  
Elastic  
Ribbon or rickrack for trim

Washcloth slippers make a wonderful gift for those who do a lot of traveling, as they take up almost no space in a suitcase. In addition, they make great bazaar or flea market items. Check the stores for “bundles” of washcloths, which would be much cheaper to buy – however, be sure that they come in sets of two per color, if the bundles aren’t all one color.

Fold each washcloth in half and sew the ends together, leaving about 1 ½” open at the top edges. Fold the top edge to the outside and stitch around about ½” from the top.

Put elastic through the seam to keep the slippers on the foot and sew a bow of matching or contrasting ribbon on the front of the shoes.

For men's slippers, stitch rickrack around the top and leave off the ribbon.
